- 1. Only the following works shall be carried out to the Hornbeam tree in the rear garden of 37 St Nicholas Mount, Hemel Hempstead:
- a) Thin the crown by a maximum of 20% to include removal of dead and damaged branches
- b) Lift the crown by a maximum of 2m over the garden shed
- c) Remove the lowest left branch (as viewed from the rear of number 37) back to the trunk. (All cuts are to be made to suitable branch junctions).

<u>Reason</u>: For the avoidance of doubt over the works permitted and to ensure that the health and amenity value of the tree is maintained.

2. All the works hereby permitted shall be carried out to B. S. 3998:1989 Recommendations for Tree Work.

Reason: To ensure a satisfactory standard of tree work.
