## REASONS FOR REFUSAL APPLICABLE TO APPLICATION: 4/00720/98/FUL

Date of Decision: 26 November 1998

- 1. The proposed development would be contrary to the provisions of Policy 8 of the adopted Dacorum Borough Local Plan and Policy 9 of the Dacorum Borough Local Plan 1991-2011 Deposit Draft for the following reasons:
- (a) it would cause harm to the surrounding neighbourhood and the adjacent property by reason of general noise and disturbance;
- (b) it does not provide sufficient parking;
- (c) it does not provide reasonable access to the first floor for people with disabilities;
- (d) it would result in harm from pollution due to noise and poor air quality.
- 2. There is no evidence to show that the existing first floor residential accommodation cannot reasonably be made self-contained. Accordingly, the proposal is contrary to the provisions of Policy 14 of the adopted Dacorum Borough Plan and Policy 16 of the Dacorum Borough Plan 1991-2011 Deposit Draft.
