1. The development hereby permitted shall be begun before the expiration of five years from the date of this permission.

Reason: To comply with the requirements of Section 91 (1) of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990.

- 2. The development hereby permitted shall be constructed in the following materials:
- (a) second hand bricks in accordance with the samples submitted to the local planning authority, but excluding the undersized brick type;
- (b) second hand clay tiles in accordance with the samples submitted to the local planning authority on 28 June 1999, but excluding the oversized tile type;
- (c) white painted timber joinery;

or such other materials as may be agreed in writing by the local planning authority.

<u>Reason</u>: To ensure a satisfactory appearance to the development, to safeguard the character and appearance of the Listed Building and in the interests of the visual amenities of the Conservation Area.

3. Notwithstanding the details submitted relating to the ridge tile, a sample of the ridge tile shall be submitted to and approved in writing by the local planning authority prior to it being installed.

<u>Reason</u>: To ensure a satisfactory appearance to the development, to safeguard the character and appearance of the Listed Building and in the interests of the visual amenities of the Conservation Area.
