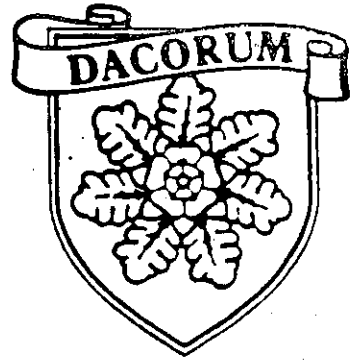

| Tree 1 (Beech) | (a) Crown thin by maximum of 20%.
(b) Shorten back lateral branches towards property by maximum of 2m.
(c) Remove low branches over boundary. |
| Tree 2 (Lime) | (a) Crown thin by maximum of 20%.
(b) Remove lower epicormic growth. |
| Tree 3 (Larch) | (a) Carry out corrective pruning to improve shape.
(b) Remove any dead wood, weak, crossing or superfluous branches as necessary. |

Reason: The works are designed to remove deadwood, improve the appearance of the tree and reduce nuisance.
