

1. The works referred to in Condition 2 shall be carried out within two years of the date of this decision.

Reason: In the interests of safeguarding the long term health of the preserved tree.

2. This permission relates only to the following works:-
  - a) The removal of dead wood, weak, crossing or superfluous branches, as necessary in the interests of the health of the tree.
  - b) Crown thinning by a maximum of 30%

Reason: The above approved works are necessary. The specified works will reduce the moisture uptake of the preserved tree in the long term interests of its health. Also, for the avoidance of doubt.

3. All the works subject to Condition 2 shall be carried out in accordance with British Standard 3398:1989 Recommendations for Tree Work.
