- 1. The development to which this permission relates shall be begun within a period of five years commencing on the date of this notice.
 - Reason: To comply with the provisions of s.91 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990.
- 2. The materials used externally shall match both in colour and texture those on the existing building of which this development shall form a part.
 - Reason: To ensure a satisfactory appearance.
- 3. The windows in the extension hereby permitted shall be cast iron lattice to match the existing windows.
 - Reason: In the interests of preserving the character and appearance of the building.
- 4. The rooflights in the extension hereby permitted shall be Velux GVA Heritage rooflights unless agreed in writing by the local planning authority.
 - Reason: In the interests of preserving the character and appearance of the building.
- 5. The chamfer detailing around the new windows shall match exactly the detailing around the windows in the house.
