D.O.L. Circular 7/77 - Notice of Proposed Development by Department
Erection of 45m high lattice mast, stationing of building and
security fence,
Land at Bovington Airfield, Chesham Road, Bovington

I refer to your consultation dated 3rd June 1981 under Circular 7/77
in respect of the above development. The matter was considered by
this Council's Development Control Committee on 30th July 1981.

The Council wish to object to the proposed siting of the mast as shown
on the submitted drawings. It is considered that the siting is too
prominent by reason of its close proximity to a busy highway and that
its siting is such that it would not be practicable to provide adequate
screening to reduce the impact of the proposed mast upon the general
amenities of the locality. The Council would however be prepared to
accept the proposal if an alternative and less prominent site could
be found and have suggested that a site meeting is arranged to investi-
gate alternative, less prominent sites. In accordance with paragraph
... 12 of Circular 7/77, I enclose herewith copies of letters received
from local residents, etc. and the Bovington Parish Council in respect
of the proposal.
