Policies of the Development Plan aim to safeguard the residential and visual amenity of the Borough and in this respect extensions are expected to harmonise with the existing house and its surroundings and must not adversely effect the residential amenity of adjoining dwellinghouses. To this effect Policy 8 of the Dacorum Borough Local Plan Deposit Draft and Proposed Modifications specifies that development will not be permitted if it fails to satisfy a range of criteria. The local planning authority is of the opinion that the proposal fails to satisfy criteria (A), (C) and (D) of Policy 8 as it detracts from the appearance of this established residential area, as well as the residential amenity of No. 12 Standring Rise.
