## CONDITIONS APPLICABLE TO APPLICATION: 4/00794/99/TPO

Date of Decision: 21 June 1999

1. The work hereby authorised shall be completed within two years of the date of the decision notice.

Reason: To ensure that any change in circumstances or in the condition of the trees is taken into account.

- 2. This consent only relates to the following the trees as identified on Plan A and to the works specified below:
- (a)T67 Fell;
- (b)T65 and T68 Reduction of the crowns of both Horse Chestnut Trees by a maximum of 50 %, ensuring as far as possible that the natural shape of both crowns is maintained.

Reason: In the interests of safety and amenity.

- 3. Tree T67 shall be replaced with one of the following in the first planting season following the removal of this tree:
- Field Maple (Acer campestre); (a)
- Scots Pine (Pinus sylvestris); (b)
- European Larch (Larix decidua). (c)

For the purposes of this condition the planting season extends from 1 October in any year to 31 March in the following calendar year.

Reason: In the interests of amenity.

4. All work shall be carried out in accordance with B.S.3998:1989 "Recommendations for tree work".

Reason: To ensure a satisfactory standard of tree work.

## INFORMATIVE:

Tree T67 should be felled as soon as possible as there is extensive decay at the base of the tree and the Horse Chesnut is in a dangerous condition. Works to trees T65 and T68 should also be carried out as soon as possible. These trees have defects and the works are required to improve safety.
