1. This consent is granted for a period of eighteen calender months commencing on the date of this notice.

Reason: (a)to ensure that the signs are removed when no longer required, as the site is within the designated Chilterns Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty; (b)to comply with the provisions of the Town and Country Planning (Control of Advertisements) Regulations 1992.

2. Any advertisements displayed, and any site used for the display of advertisements shall be maintained in a clean and tidy condition to the reasonable satisfaction of the local planning authority.

3. Any structure or hoarding erected or used principally for the purpose of displaying advertisements shall be maintained in a safe condition.
