

1. The works for which this consent is granted shall be begun before the expiration of five years from the date of this consent.

Reason: To comply with section 18 of the Planning (Listed Building and Conservation Areas) Act 1990.

2. Notwithstanding the details shown on the approved drawings, the hanging and fascia signs shall be hand painted only and the works hereby authorised shall not make any use of, or incorporate any, "Foamex" material in any of the signs which are the subject of this consent.

Reason: In the interests of listed building and for the avoidance of doubt.

3. Before any of the signs hereby authorised are installed, the existing fascia and two hanging signs and two spotlights shall be wholly removed from the site and there shall be no means of external illumination of the advertisements.

Reason: In the interests of the listed building and for the avoidance of doubt.

- 4. The hanging signs subject to this consent shall be installed fully in accordance with the bracket details shown on Drawing No.1939 and thereafter shall be permanently retained, and all signs subject to this consent shall be finished in the following colours:
- a) Background: Blue Matt BS 300 C;
- b) Lettering:
 - (i) 'Home': White;
 - (ii) 'Finders': Gold:
 - (iii) Telephone No. and 'Most Accommodating People': White;
- c) Edging: Gold.

Reason: In the interests of the listed building and for the avoidance of doubt.

5. This consent does not relate to the approval of the planting trough as shown on Drawing No. 1939.

Reason: In the interests of safeguarding the listed building and for the avoidance of doubt.
