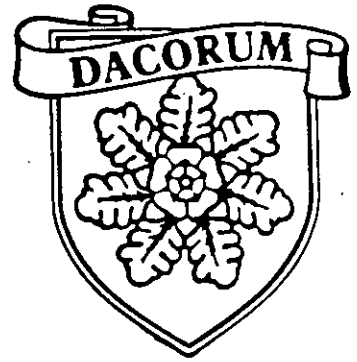

In his decision on the Enforcement Notice appeal, ref: 4/0438/91EN (T/APP/C/91/A1910/607672/P6) the Inspector concluded that the disposition of windows on the northern part of the south east elevation "has a domestic appearance that looks out of place on the listed building, within the historic group of farm buildings. These alterations to the approved plans are significantly more harmful to the character of the listed building, its features of historic importance and the setting of the adjoining farmhouse, and therefore, in my view should be removed".

The local planning authority concurs with this view.
