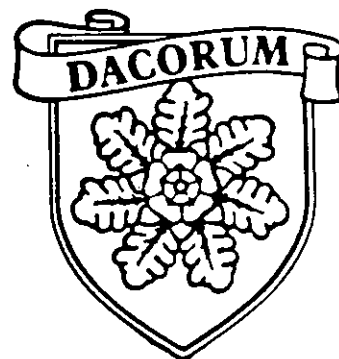

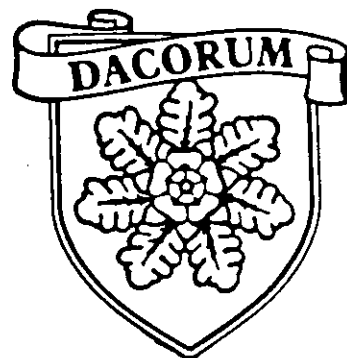

REASONS FOR REFUSAL
OF APPLICATION: 4/0812/96

1. The proposed development would result in a two storey extension on the flank boundary of the dwelling. Such an extension is contrary to policies contained in the Dacorum Borough Plan. The proposed extension would close the gap between the two dwellings which, if repeated, would lead, to the appearance of a terraced row of dwellings which would significantly detract from the character and appearance of the area.
2. The proposed extension shows a parapet detail on the gable end of the dwelling. The dwelling and adjacent dwellings have a normal eaves detail and the introduction of the parapet as proposed would introduce an incongruous feature which would unbalance the pair of semi-detached dwellings which would significantly detract from the appearance of the dwelling and adjacent dwellings and street scene generally.
