TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971 - SECTION 271 TOWN AND COUNTRY AMENITIES ACT 1974 - SECTION 7 APPLICATION FOR LISTED BUILDING CONSENT 'THE LOCKERS', BURY HILL, HEMEL HEMPSTEAD

I am directed by the Secretary of State for the Environment to refer to your letter of 22 October 1979, regarding the County Council's application for listed building consent to construct a steel fire escape from the first floor with a new exit door on to the staircase in place of an existing window at 'The Lockers', Bury Hill, Hemel Hempstead. The application was made in accordance with the provisions of Regulation 11 of the Town and Country Planning (Listed Buildings and Buildings in Conservation Areas) Regulations 1977.

- The information submitted with the County Council's application has been considered, and it is noted that no objections have been raised to the proposed works. The Secretary of State is satisfied that the proposed works are acceptable insofar as the character of 'The Lockers' as a building of special architectural or historic interest is concerned, and accordingly he hereby grants listed building consent for works of alteration to 'The Lockers', Bury Hill, Hemel Hempstead, as described in the Council's application form dated 14 June 1979 and as shown on the accompanying drawings, Nos. E528/MW1/78 and E528/MW2/79.
- This letter does not convey any approval or consent required under any enactment, bye-law, order or regulation, other than Sections 55 and 56 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971.
