The proposal would result in a form of development which would be detrimental to the character and visual appearance of the area as a whole and would have a detrimental effect on the amenities of the surrounding properties. The introduction of flats would result in an over-intensification of activity on the site and the provision of car parking to the required standard would result in disturbance and loss of privacy to the adjacent residential properties. In addition, the increased use of the existing sub-standard access to Gravel Path would give rise to conditions prejudicial to road safety.
