CONDITION

This permission shall be for a limited period of two years expiring on 31st October, 1989. On or before that date the use hereby permitted shall be discontinued and the premises reinstated to the satisfaction of the County Planning Authority.

Statement

The Officer in charge house is no longer needed for that purpose, and has been vacant since 31 December 1986.

There is a need for office accommodation for Intermediate Treatment Officers, and it is proposed to make use of this property for that purpose.

The accommodation will be required for a temporary period until alternative office accommodation becomes available.

Four full time officers will operate from the proposed office and only minor internal alterations to the building will be required.

Car parking is available, making use of the existing space to the front of Adeyfield Lodge.
