- 1. I am directed by the Secretary of State for the Environment to refer to your letter of 11 September 1989 regarding your application for listed building consent to replace and modify the design of the existing front doors at the Old Town Hall, High Street, Hemel Hempstead, Hertfordshire. The application was made in accordance with the provisions of Regulation 13 of the Town and Country Planning (Listed Buildings and Buildings in Conservation Areas) Regulations 1987.
- 2. The information submitted with your Council®s application has been considered and it is noted that no representations were received as a result of public advertisement of the proposals. The Secretary of State is satisfied that the works are acceptable in so far as the character of this building of special architectural or historic interest is concerned. Accordingly he hereby grants listed building consent to replace and modify the design of the existing front doors at The Old Town Hall, High Street, Hemel Hempstead as referred to in application number 4/0853/89LBDC dated 8 May 1989 and as shown on the accompanying drawing number 15/01/33/6, subject to the condition that works hereby permitted shall be begun within 5 years from the date of this letter.
- 3. This letter does not convey any approval or consent required under any enactment, bye-law, order or regulation, other than Sections 55 and 56 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971.
