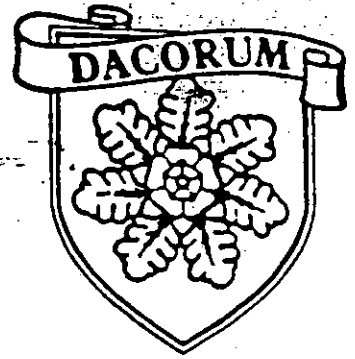

1. This consent only relates to works to Tree T1 of Dacorum Borough Council Tree Preservation Order 248.

Reason: For the avoidance of doubt.

2. This consent only relates to the carrying out of the following works:

- (a) Removal of any dead wood, weak, crossing or superfluous branches, as necessary.

Reason: For the avoidance of doubt.

- (b) Shortening bulk of lateral branches extending towards the property by removing the lowest secondary branch.

Reason: In the interests of residential amenity.

- (c) Lifting the crown over the garden by reducing the tips of the lowest lateral branches.

Reason: In the interests of residential amenity.

3. All the works specified by Condition 2 shall be carried out in accordance with British Standard 3998: Recommendations for Tree Work.

Reasons: To ensure proper standards of tree work are carried out and for the avoidance of doubt.
