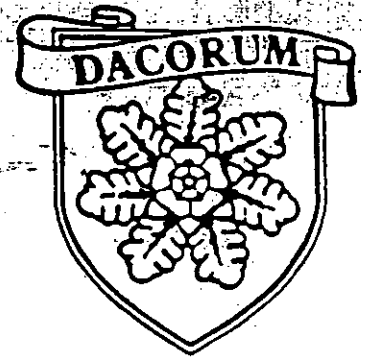

Only the following work shall be permitted in accordance with BS.3998 (1989):

1. All crown thinning must not exceed 20%. Dead/dying/diseased branches, as well as crossing branches, may be taken.
2. Reduction of hawthorn and limbs of the purple beech must be to a suitable fork, retaining shape of crown (regarding purple beech).
3. Pruning to cypresses must retain form of tree.
4. Removal of dead wood from trunk top of juniper should not be cut into live wood.

Reason: Thinning of field maple and purple beech will allow under-storey plants more light, benefiting ground flora, likewise with reducing beech limbs over the garden. Integrating the hawthorn, already outgoing, its allocated area into an existing hedge. Reshaping cypresses due to their being large specimens in a small garden. Removing dead wood from juniper, because unsightly and could be a potential hazard if it was to fall.
