1. That only the 2 trees on the southern edge of Group 7 are felled. Both are indicated on the attached plan.

Reason: Tree A is a small specimen which has been suppressed by adjacent trees. It has extensive bark wounds at the base caused by past fire damage.

- 2. That only the following works are carried out to the 2 Beech in Group 6:
 - (a) shorten back lateral branches extending towards property by a maximum of 4 m ensuring that cuts are made at a suitable fork or side branch;
 - (b) selectively thin remainder of crowns by a maximum of 20%;
 - (c) remove deadwood, snags and any weak or crossing branches.

<u>Reason</u>: Tree B is an over-mature specimen which is showing signs of decline. It contains extensive decay at the base of the trunk to over 2 m above ground level.

3. All works shall be carried out in accordance with BS 3998: Recommendations for Tree Work.

Reason: The pruning works will alleviate nuisance to the property without detracting significantly from the amenity value of the trees.
