- 1. The proposed use would attract a significant amount of vehicular and pedestrian traffic to the site which would, especially during the evening, cause a significant amount of disturbance to the occupants of the dwellings surrounding the site reducing their amenities to a level below that which they would normally expect to enjoy. The proposal would, therefore, be contrary to the aims of Policy 8 of the Dacorum Borough Local Plan.
- 2. The air purification system proposed is not satisfactory because the carbon filters may not be sufficient to cope with odours produced by the business. In addition a low discharge point is proposed which would not allow sufficient dilution of odours. The air purification system is not adequate and the dispersal of odours would significantly detract from the residential amenities of the occupants of nearby dwellings reducing their amenities to a level below that which they would normally expect to enjoy. The proposal would, therefore, be contrary to the aims of Policy 8 of the Dacorum Borough Local Plan.
- 3. The site lies within Hemel Hempstead Old Town Conservation Area, and the use proposed and associated vehicular activity along with the potential odour pollution would significantly detract from the area's special character. The proposal would, therefore, be contrary to the aims of Policy 110 of the Dacorum Borough Local Plan.
