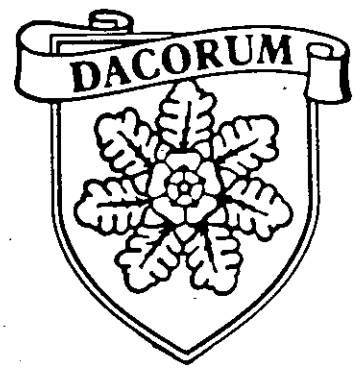

REASONS FOR REFUSAL
OF APPLICATION: 4/0868/91

The adopted Dacorum District Plan shows the site to be within the Chilterns Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty wherein the policy of the local planning authority seeks to preserve the appearance of the area, encourage agriculture and conserve wildlife by the restriction of further development having particular regard to the siting, design and external appearance of buildings. The proposed agricultural storage building would be a very large and imposing structure in an isolated position in a very sensitive location. Such a building would, if permitted, prove severely injurious to the character and amenity of the surrounding open countryside.
