- 1. The adopted Dacorum District Plan shows the site to be within the Chilterns Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty wherein the policy of the local planning authority seeks to preserve the appearance of the area, encourage agriculture and conserve wildlife by the restriction of further development, having particular regard to the siting, design and external appearance of buildings. The proposed poultry units would be very large and imposing structures in an isolated position in a very sensitive location, which would along with the proposed access track, if permitted, prove severely injurious to the character and amenity of the surrounding countryside.
- 2. The proposals lack sufficient details to fully assess the extent of the impact of the proposed development on the surrounding countryside, however it is evident from the information submitted that the proposals would be seriously detrimental to their setting in the Chilterns Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty.
