

WHEREAS in accordance with the Building Regulations plans were deposited by you, or on your behalf, or on behalf of your predecessor in title on the 2nd day of September, 1974 with the ~~former~~ Dacorum District Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in respect of a proposed work at Little Marlins, Shootersway, Berkhamsted of which the reference number is 934/74D.
