1. The works for which this consent is granted shall be begun before the expiration of five years from the date of this consent.

<u>Reason</u>: To comply with section 18 of the Planning (Listed Building and Conservation Areas) Act 1990.

2. All windows and doors shall be in painted timber and in accordance with details shown on the Window Schedule SHB900B.

Reason: In the interests of preserving the character and appearance of the building.

3. All fencing in or around the courtyard shall be closeboarded fencing with timber posts unless agreed in writing by the local planning authority.

Reason: In the interests of preserving the character and appearance of the building.

4. All new and replacement rainwater goods and external soil and pipework shall be in cast iron.

<u>Reason</u>: In the interests of preserving the character and appearance of the building.

5. All new and replacement roof tiles, ridge tiles and vent cowls to chimneys shall be in clay and in no other material unless otherwise agreed in writing by the local planning authority.

<u>Reason</u>: In the interests of preserving the character and appearance of the building.

6. All mechanical, electrical and public health services shall comply with the specification given in the document submitted by J E Greatorex & Partners, ref.AWS/MJS/APJ/VS/4984.
