# PROPOSED RETENTION OF SINGLE MOBILE CLASSROOM UNIT BRIDGEWATER MIDDLE SCHOOL, BRIDLE WAY, BERKHAMSTED Condition to be attached to planning permission (4/947-99)

### TIME LIMIT

This planning permission shall be for a limited period of five years expiring on 31 July 2004. On or before that date the buildings retained under this permission shall be removed and the land cleared and reinstated to the satisfaction of the County Planning Authority.

<u>Reason</u>: To enable the County Planning Authority to exercise proper control over development on this Green Belt site and to ensure that the unit, which when first permitted in 1994 was intended to be a temporary measure, does not remain there indefinitely.
