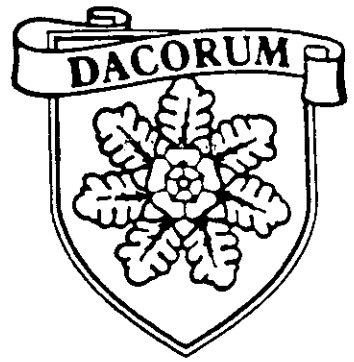
DEMOLITION OF EXISTING TIMBER OUTBUILDING, ERECTION OF TWO STOREY REAR EXTENSION

1. The development to which this permission relates shall be begun within a period of five years commencing on the date of this notice.

Reason: To comply with the provisions of s.91 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990.

2. The walls of the extension shall be rendered and painted in a colour to match the existing property.

Reason: To preserve the character and appearance of this listed building.

3. The windows and doors in the extension hereby permitted shall be white painted timber.

Reason: To preserve the character and appearance of this listed building.

4. The roof of the extension shall be in long straw to match the existing roof of the property and the valleys at the junction of the new roof and the original roof shall be in reed straw.

Reason: In order to provide some protection to the old roof at the junction.

5. The roof shall be provided with a flush ridge with a long straw thatch.

Reason: To preserve the character and appearance of this listed building.

6. The windows on the first floor shall be of "eyebrow" design, details of which shall be submitted to and approved by the local planning authority before any work is commenced on site.

Reason: To ensure that the features are designed and constructed in a manner that is technically possible to thatch satisfactorily.

7. The window at first floor level on the north-east elevation shall be fitted with obscure glazing and retained in this condition.

Reason: To safeguard the amenities of the adjacent property.
