- 1. All work must be carried out in accordance with British Standard 3998 (1989) Recommendation for Tree Work.
- 2. Work in respect of trees. T1 and T2 shall be limited to the following:
 - (a) Reduce crown by a maximum of 40%, cutting back to a suitable side branch or growing point.
 - (b) Remove dead wood, snags and any weak, crossing or superfluous branches.
- 3. Work to tree T3 shall comprise:
 - (a) Remove dead wood, snags and crossing branches as necessary.
 - (b) Reduce lateral branches by a maximum of 3 m.
 - (c) Reshape as necessary to balance crown and maintain a natural-appearance.
- 4. Work in respect of tree T4 shall comprise:
 - (a) Remove any dead wood, snags and crossing branches as necessary.
 - (b) Thin crown by a maximum of 20%.
 - (c) Reduce overlong laterals by a maximum of 3 m.
 - D Reduce crown by a maximum of 2 m.

REASONS:

- 1. To ensure satisfactory execution of the works.
- 2. The proposed works will reduce the danger of wind throw to the Hornbeam and rebalance the crown of the Horse Chestnut.
- 3. The proposed work will reduce the possibility of lateral branches being broken from the Sycamore.
- 4. The proposed works will reduce the possibility of wind damage to the Beech.
