1. The development hereby permitted shall be begun before the expiration of five years from the date of this permission.

Reason: To comply with the requirements of Section 91 (1) of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990.

2. The roofs in all parts of the extension hereby permitted (except for the conservatory) shall comprise natural slate.

Reason: To ensure a satisfactory appearance.

3. The brick work shall match the existing brick of the house unless otherwise agreed in writing by the local planning authority.

Reason: In the interests of the visual amenities of the Conservation Area.

4. The windows shall be painted timber and shall match in style, design and appearance the existing windows in the house unless otherwise agreed in writing by the local planning authority.

Reason: To ensure a satisfactory appearance.

5. The garage hereby permitted shall be used primarily only for the storage of domestic motor vehicles.

<u>Reason</u>: To ensure the adequate and satisfactory provision of off-street vehicle parking facilities

6. The extensions hereby permitted shall not be occupied at any time otherwise than for primary residential purposes as part of the dwelling known as 9 Langdon Street & 15 Albert Street, Tring.

<u>Reason</u>: To safeguard and maintain the strategic policies of the local planning authority as expressed in the Structure Plan and Dacorum Borough Local Plan and for the avoidance of doubt.
