- 1. The works to which this consent relates shall be begun within a period of 5 years from the date of this notice.
- 2. No work shall be started on the works hereby permitted until details of materials, including window frames, brickwork and mortar, to be used externally shall have been submitted to and approved by the local planning authority and the works hereby permitted shall be carried out in the materials so approved.
- 3. The brickwork bonding, coursing and pointing shall match that part of the existing building to which the works abut.
- 4. All guttering to the proposed works shall match that on the part of the existing building to which the works abut.
- 5. Not withstanding the details shown on the approved plans the two window openings to the ground floor of the south-western elevation shall have gauged brick arches to match those of the existing building.
- 6. No work shall be started on the works hereby permitted until details of all materials to be used for hard landscaping shall have been submitted to and approved by the local planning authority and the works hereby permitted shall be carried out in the materials so approved.
