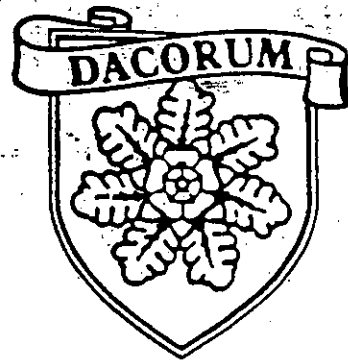

That the tree be felled to ground level and a replacement such as a Chinese Red Barked Birch (*Betulus Albosinensis*) be planted in the garden, not necessarily near to the felled Lime. But replacement will not grow to such a size as the Lime has done.

Reason: The tree is over 20 m high and less than 8 m from the property, and the tree is not a particularly good specimen. Since previously a large limb has been removed, which has not strictly speaking visually unbalanced the tree, but the wound left, externally has no cavity and does not appear to have received any parasitic or saprophytic invasion, however this is not an internal appreciation, the trunk tissues surrounding the branch tissues may not have compartmentalised effectively, so the trunk tissues may be dead or dying internally weakening the tree making it more susceptible to parasitic attack.
