Re: 38 Crouchfield, Hemel Hempstead - Section 53  
Determination.

I refer to your letter of 12th November regarding an application to sell bottled wine from the above address. The matter has now been given consideration and I am able to inform you that, subject to certain provisions, it will not be necessary for you to obtain planning permission for the use proposed.

The basis of this determination is that there is no intention on your part to either display wine in view of the public, or in any other way to advertise the sale of wine from the house. In the event of output being increased to such an extent that it becomes necessary to change the scope of your marketing operations to attract larger numbers of the general public, the matter will, of course, have to be reviewed and in all probability a planning application submitted.
