1. The development hereby permitted shall be begun before the expiration of five years from the date of this permission.

Reason: To comply with the requirements of Section 91 (1) of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990.

2. No development shall take place until samples of the materials proposed to be used on the external walls/roofs of the development have been submitted to, and approved in writing by the local planning authority. The approved materials shall be used in the implementation of the development.

Reason: To ensure a satisfactory appearance to the development.

3. At all time all the area hatched orange on Drawing No.80.034 shall be available for the parking of 2 vehicles and the garage shall at all times be available for vehicle parking.

Reason: To ensure that adequately parking is permanently provided within the residential curtilage of the dwellighouse.

4. Notwithstanding the details L(90)002 this permission only relates to the position of the wall shown by Drawing L(--)001.

Reason: For the avoidance of doubt and in the interests of highway safety.

5. There shall only be a single vehicular access serving the dwellinghouse as shown by the details specified by Drawing No.L(--) 001and a 2m x 2m visibility splay shall be provided to each side of this access as measured from the back edge of the public footpath within which there shall be no obstruction to visibility between 600mm and 2m above footpath level.

Reason: In the interests of highways safety and for the avoidance.
