1) The development hereby permitted shall be begun before the expiration of five years from the date of this permission.

<u>Reason</u>: To comply with the requirements of Section 91 (1) of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990.

- 2. Only the following works shall be carried out to Trees T1-T4 as identified on the applicants plan (received 16 June 1998) for four Beech trees.
- T1, T2, T3 Reduce back branches which overhang the gardens by 1/3, approximately 4m.
- T4 Raise crown by 3m. Reduce branches which overhang the gardens by 1/3 approximately 4m. Crown thin by 20%, to include any dead, dying or damaged branches.

All cuts are to be made to suitable branch junctions.

<u>Reason</u>:For the avoidance of doubt as to the work to be carried out and to maintain the trees health and amenity value.

3. All works to be carried out in accordance with BS3998 1989 'Recommendations for Tree Work'.

Reason: To ensure a satisfactory standard of tree work.
