CONDITIONS APPLICABLE TO APPLICATION: 4/01047/97/TPO

1. The works hereby permitted shall be carried out in accordance with B.S. 3998 1989 Recommendations for tree work.

Reason: To ensure a satisfactory standard of tree work.

2. Tree 1- Beech shall be felled and a replacement shall be planted in the first planting season following the removal of the tree. The replacement shall be a Hornbeam - Carpinus betulus and shall be planted as close as practically possible to the position of the existing tree. The replacement shall be a standard (2.75 to 3m) overall height with a stem circumference of 8 to 10cm measured 1m above ground level.

Reason: In the interests of amenity.

3. Only the following works shall be carried out to Trees 2, 3 and 4:

Tree 2 - Beech

Shorten back long lateral side branches to a suitable side branch or growing point, remove ivy, remove deadwood, weak or crossing branches.

Tree 3 - Beech

Shorten back large limb growing towards the High Street to a suitable side branch or growing point, remove deadwood, weak or crossing branches.

Tree 4 - Lime

Shorten back long lateral side branches to a suitable side branch or growing point, remove deadwood, weak or crossing branches.

Reason: In the interest of the trees and amenity.
