1. The work hereby authorised shall be completed within two years of the date of the decision notice.

<u>Reason</u>: To ensure that any change in circumstances or in the condition of the trees is taken into account.

- 2. Only the following works shall be carried out to the trees specified as T1, T2, T3 and T7 in the application:
- T1 Horse Chestnut reduce lateral branches overhanging house, road and turning head, ensuring that cuts are made at a suitable fork or growing point, selectively thin the crown by a maximum of 20%, and remove epicormic shoots.
- <u>T2 Sycamore</u> reduce lateral branches overhanging roof of property by 50% and tip reduce upper crown by a maximum of 1-2 metres.
- T3 Walnut reduce lateral spread by a maximum of 2 metres, balance crown where necessary and selectively thin crown by a maximum of 20%.
- T7 Beech (on neighbouring property) shorten back lateral branches extending over garden by a maximum of 3 metres, ensuring that cuts are made at a suitable fork or growing point.

Reason: For the avoidance of doubt as to the extent of the authorised works.

3. All work shall be carried out in accordance with B.S.3998:1989 "Recommendations for tree work".
