**2. Details of any exterior lighting shall be submitted to and approved in writing by the local planning authority prior to its installation.**

Reason: In the interests of safeguarding the local environment.

**3. The trees shown on Drawing No. 98045/91646/MPC01/01 Rev. B shall not be cut down, uprooted or destroyed, lopped or topped without the written approval of the local planning authority**

Reason: In the interests of the appearance of the area.

**4. The telecommunications mast and cabin shall be removed from the site as soon as reasonably practicable after they are no longer required for telecommunication purposes.**

Reason: In the interests of safeguarding the appearance of the area.
