## CONDITIONS APPLICABLE TO APPLICATION: 4/01064/98/FHA

Date of Decision: 26 August 1998

1. The development hereby permitted shall be begun before the expiration of five years from the date of this permission.

<u>Reason</u>: To comply with the requirements of Section 91 (1) of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990.

2. The materials to be used in the construction of the external surfaces of the extension hereby permitted shall match in size, colour and texture those used on the existing building.

Reason: To ensure a satisfactory appearance to the development.

3. The development hereby permitted shall not commence until the new driveway has been constructed in accordance with the details shown on plans 4/1064/98 and the area of new driveway shown unshaded on drawing number 3 of plans 4/1064/98 shall be constructed using the no dig method of construction.

<u>Reason</u>: To prevent damage to the Oak tree which is covered by a Tree Preservation Order.

4. Notwithstanding the details shown on plans 4/1064/98 the preserved Oak tree shown on drawing number 3 of plans 4/1064/98 shall be protected during the whole period of site excavation and construction by the erection and retention of cleft chestnut pale fencing in accordance with B S 5837 at the edge of the new drive with the grassed area.

<u>Reason</u>: In order to ensure that damage does not occur to the tree during building operations.
