1. All pruning works shall be carried out to standards set out in B.S. 3998:1989 'Recommendations for Tree Works'.

Reason: B.S. 3998:1989 will ensure proper standards of tree pruning to maintain their visual amenity.

2. Beech trees T3 and T4 shall be cut back from the power lines to give a 2-3m clearance only. The crowns shall be thinned by no more than 10% and only the lateral branches that directly overhang 'Watling Garth' shall be cut back, and by no more than 25%.

<u>Reason</u>: Thinning the crowns by 10% will reduce the 'sail' effect. Reduction of the lower branches over 'Watling Garth' will alleviate weight stress. Clearing the power lines by 2-3m will abate present and future nuisance problems.

3. Works to sycamores T1 and T2 shall be restricted to the reduction of lateral branches by no more than 25%, and there shall be no reduction in height of these two trees.

Reason: Reducing lateral branches by 25% will alleviate weight stress and balance the crowns.
