The support columns hereby permitted shall be removed from the land on or before 20 October 2000 unless the local planning authority shall have given approval in writing for the continued use of the main floodlights (as defined in Condition 2 of planning permission 4/0946/97FUL dated 21 November 1997) after this date.

3. The support columns hereby permitted shall be positioned on the north-west side of the floodlight columns labelled "1", "2" and "3" on Drawing No. LGFC/X2.
