1. The development hereby permitted shall be begun before the expiration of five years from the date of this permission.

Reason: To comply with the requirements of Section 91 (1) of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990.

2. The materials to be used in the construction of the external surfaces of the extension hereby permitted shall match in size, colour and texture those used on the existing building.

<u>Reason</u>: To ensure a satisfactory appearance to the development and in the interests of the visual amenities of the Conservation Area.

3. The development hereby permitted shall not be occupied until the arrangements for vehicle parking shown on Drawing No. 9901/2 Rev A shall have been provided, and they shall not be used thereafter otherwise than for the purposes approved.

<u>Reason</u>: To ensure the adequate and satisfactory provision of off-street vehicle parking facilities.

4. The development hereby permitted, together with the remainder of the property of which it shall form a part, shall not be used otherwise than for purposes of a single dwellinghouse and for no other purpose within ClassC3 of the Schedule to the Town and Country Planning (Use Classes) Order 1987, or in any provision equivalent to that Class in any statutory instrument revoking and re-enacting that Order with or without modification.

Reason: To ensure that the dwelling house is used as a single household at all times.

5. All new windows and doors shall be constructed in painted timber and thereafter retained in this condition.

<u>Reason</u>:To ensure a satisfactory appearance to the dwelling and to the Berkhamsted Conservation Area.

6. The balustrade and escape stairs shall be constructed in black painted metal and thereafter retained in this condition.

Reason: To ensure a satisfactory appearance to the dwellinghouse and Berkhamsted Conservation Area.
