 The works to which this consent relates shall be begun within a period of five years commencing on the date of this notice.

 $\frac{\text{Reason:}}{\text{Buildings}}$  To comply with the provision of s.18 of the Planning (Listed Buildings and Conservation Areas) Act 1990.

The boundary wall shall not be demolished until arrangements have been made to the satisfaction of the local planning authority for the protection of the beech tree and horse chestnut tree covered by the Tree Preservation Order No 269 under British Standard 5837 (Trees in relation to construction 1991).

Reason: To safeguard the preservation of the trees.

3. All materials from the demolished wall shall be removed from the site within 28 days of the completion of work.

 $\underline{\text{Reason}}$ : To ensure a satisfactory appearance to the site within  $\underline{\text{Berkhamsted}}$  Conservation  $\underline{\text{Area}}$ .

4. No materials shall be stored within the crown spread of the trees on the embankment.

Reason: To safeguard the protection of the trees.
