1. The development hereby permitted shall be begun before the expiration of five years from the date of this permission.

<u>Reason</u>: To comply with the requirements of Section 91 (1) of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990.

2. The premises shall only be used as a restaurant and not for the sale of food for consumption off the premises.

<u>Reason</u>: In the interests of residential amenity and to avoid parking problems in the vicinity of the premises.

3. The use hereby permitted shall not be commenced until there has been submitted to and approved by the local planning authority a scheme for ventilation of the premises, including the extraction and filtration of cooking fumes; and before any refrigeration or air conditioning equipment is used on the premises, it shall be enclosed with sound insulating material and mounted in a way which will minimise transmission of structure borne sound in accordance with the scheme to be submitted to and approved by the local planning authority. The schemes referred to in this condition shall be carried out as approved prior to the commencement of the use hereby permitted.

Reason: In the interests of the amenity of adjoining residents.

4. The level of noise emitted from the site shall not exceed LAeq 5 mins 52dB (with a background level not exceeding 45dB(A) L90) between 5.00 pm and 11.30 pm on Mondays to Saturdays and between 12.00 noon and 9.30 pm on Sundays, Bank Holidays and Public Holidays, as measured on the boundary of the site at the location notated "C" on the approved plan. The measurements shall be taken at a height of 1.2 m above ground level except where the site is enclosed by a wall or other sound opaque structure at or near the boundary, when measurements shall be taken at a position high enough to measure the noise coming over the top of such a structure.

Reason: In the interests of the amenity of adjoining residents.

5. The premises shall only be open to customers between 8.00 am and 11.30 pm on Mondays to Saturdays, and between 12.00 noon and 9.30 pm on Sundays, Bank Holidays and Public Holidays.

Reason: In the interests of the amenities of the occupants of neighbouring dwellings.
