 Only the beech tree indicated by cross hatching on the approved plan shall be felled.

Reason: To maintain and enhance visual amenity.

2. A replacement tree shall be planted in the first planting season following the removal of the beech tree, in a suitable location near the tree to be felled. For the purposes of this condition a planting season shall be deemed to commence in only one year on 1 October and end on 31 March in the following year.

Reason: To maintain and enhance visual amenity.

3. The replacement tree shall be of extra heavy standard size ie 4.5 m - 6.25 m overall height with a stem circumference of 16-18 cm at 1 m above ground level.

Reason: To maintain and enhance visual amenity.

- 4. The replacement tree shall be selected from any of the following species:
 - (i) Quercus Coccirea (Scarlet Oak);
 - (ii) Robinia Pseudoacacia (False Acacia);
 - (iii) Gleditisia Tricanthos 'Sunburst' (Golden Honey Locust).

Reason: To maintain and enhance visual amenity.
