- 1. Only the following works shall be carried out and in accordance with British Standard 3998:1998 Recommendation for tree work.
- (1) T3, 4, 5, 6, and 8 fell;
- (2) T2 remove branch growing over the road;
- (3) T9 shorten back long lateral branches by a maximum of 3 metres

Reason: The felling of the Beech is necessary to balance the need for safety and amenity, removing the branch will reduce the hazard to high sided vehicles and pruning the Larch will reduce the risk to property.

2. Following the removal of T3, 4, 5, 6 and 8 five replacement trees shall be planted in the subsequent planting season. The replacement planting shall be located as close as practically possible to the location of the existing trees. The replacements shall be standards ie. 2.75 to 3 metres overall height with stem girth of 8 to 10 centimeters measured 1 metre above ground level. The replacement trees shall be English oak - Quercus robur.

Reason: Replacement planting of Oak will eventually restore the visual amenity of the area.
