REASONS FOR REFUSAL APPLICABLE TO APPLICATION: 4/01140/98/OUT

Date of Decision: 26 August 1998

- 1. The application site is situated within the Metropolitan Green Belt on the adopted Dacorum Borough Local Plan wherein permission will only be given for use of land, the construction of new buildings for agricultural or other essential purposes appropriate to a rural area or small scale facilities for participatory sport or recreation. No such need has been proven and the proposed development is unacceptable in the terms of this policy.
- 2. The construction of a further two dwellings and garaging on the rear elevated part of the site will detract from the openness and character of the Conservation Area.
