PUBLIC PATH STOPPING UP ORDER

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971, SECTION 210

THE BOROUGH OF DACORUM (PART OF FOOTPATH HEMEL HEMPSTEAD NO 52)
PUBLIC PATH
STOPPING UP ORDER 1987

WHEREAS the Dacorum Borough Council is satisfied that it is necessary to stop up part of the footpath to which this Order relates to enable development to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted under Part III of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971 or the enactments replaced by that Part of the Act;

NOW THEREFORE the Dacorum Borough Council in pursuance of the powers in that behalf confirmed by s.210 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971 hereby make the following Order:-

1. That part of the footpath over the land situate between Three Cherry Trees Lane, Hemel Hempstead and the extension to Boundary Way, Hemel Hempstead, shown by a bold black line on the map annexed hereto and described in Part 1 of the Schedule hereto shall be stopped up as provided by this Order.
2. The stopping up of the footpath referred to in Article 1 above shall have effect on the confirmation of this Order.
3. Where immediately before the date on which a highway is stopped up in pursuance of this Order there is apparatus under, in, on, along or across that highway belonging to statutory undertakers for the purpose of carrying on their undertaking, the undertakers shall continue to have the same rights in respect of their apparatus as they then had.
4. This Order may be cited as "The Borough of Dacorum (Part of Footpath Hemel Hempstead No 52) Public Path Stopping Up Order 1987"


SCHEDULE

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING PATH OR WAY

O.S. Reference 0819-0868 (point D)

The path commences at a ~~junction with Three Cherry Trees Lane (point A 0821-0895)~~ and runs thence southwards for a distance of ~~450~~ ^{about 101} metres to a ~~junction with the Boundary Way extension at point B (0817-0850)~~ on the map annexed hereto. *to O.S. 
