No 35 adjoins an important and busy roundabout junction between Fishery Road with Northridge Way and St John's Road. The use of the vehicular access and associated hardstanding will be prejudicial to vehicular and pedestrian safety as the development will fail to accord with the highway standards adopted by the Council, as notwithstanding the details shown on the submitted plans the required 2.4 m x 60m sight line to the south cannot be provided to serve the access.
