

- 2. Notwithstanding the details shown on Drawing No. THS-101, no visible mild steel brackets shall be used for the works to which this consent relates. Oak brackets fixed with oak pegs and dowels shall be used in accordance with a scheme which shall be submitted to and approved by the local planning authority prior to the commencement of work. Thereafter the oak brackets, oak pegs and dowels shall be permanently retained.
- 3. Prior to the commencement of work details, at a scale of 1:20, showing a vertically boarded timber door shall have been submitted to and approved by the local planning authority and the door shall be installed in accordance with the approved scheme prior to the first floor rooms being brought into use. Thereafter the door, in its approved form, shall be permanently retained.
- 4. The existing purlin and rafters shall be re-used in accordance with the details shown on Drawing No. THS-101.
- 5. The new beam shown on Drawing No. THS-101 and THS-100A shall be constructed of oak unless otherwise agreed in writing by the local planning authority.

- 2. For the avoidance of doubt and to safeguard the character of the listed building as the use of visible steel brackets are inappropriate.
