RESOLUTION OF THE COUNTY PLANNING COMMITTEE OF 36 MARCH 1994

"That for the purposes of Regulation 5(4) of the Town & Country Planning General Regulations 1976, residential development for no more than 9 units at Rosagate JMI School, Pudding Lane, Hemel Hempstead, be authorised subject to details of access, design, external appearance and landscaping being reserved for approval of the Local Planning Authority."

Conditions:

- The development hereby permitted shall not be carried out otherwise than in accordance with detailed plans and drawings showing the siting, layout design, external appearance and landscaping of the development which shall have been approved by the District Planning Authority before the development is commanded.
- (2) a) Application for approval in respect of all matters reserved in condition (1) above shall be made to the District Planning Authority within a period of three years commencing on the date of this notice.
 - b) The development to which this permission relates shall be begun by not later than whichever is the later of the following dates :
 - (i) The expiration of a period of five years, commencing on the date of this notice.
 - (ii) The expiration of a puriod of two years commencing on the date upon which final approval is given by the District Planning Authority or by the Secretary of State or, in the case of approval given on different dates, the final approval of the last such matter to be approved by the District Planning Authority or by the Secretary of State.
